The mobility:

The ***Engage digitally, learn playfully*** youth workers mobility aims to support participants in using digital tools, AI and gamification to create inclusive and practical learning activities for young people, with special attention to those belonging to vulnerable groups. Over three days, participants will:

- Develop new skills through workshops to enhance their work with young people
- Exchange experiences and good practices with peers from Romania, Austria, Italy and Hungary
- Visit local youth organizations to learn from community-based approaches
- Participate in group-building activities and workshops to strengthen teamwork and collaboration
- Reflect at the end of each day to consolidate learning and insights
- Enjoy an international evening and informal moments to connect and share with peers from Romania, Austria, Italy and Hungary

The program is designed to help youth workers bring fresh and accessible approaches to their own practice.



We are looking for youth workers who:

- Are actively involved in non-formal education or youth work in their organization.
- Have a basic understanding of digital tools and an interest in exploring new technologies.
- Are motivated to learn and share experiences with peers from other countries.
- Are open-minded and willing to participate in group activities and discussions.
- Can communicate in English at a level that allows them to fully participate in the activities.
- Are committed to attending the full duration of the mobility.
- Are willing and able to share their learning or experience with their organization or community after the mobility and to integrate what they have learned into their daily work with young people.



Expenses

Board and lodging for the training course are fully covered by the local organizers during the program. Participants will stay in the hotel of the Youth House in Timisoara (<https://fitt.ro/hotel/>) and will be accommodated in twin or double rooms. Rooms are simple and comfortable, without any luxury. Meals will be served buffet-style, with options to accommodate all dietary needs.

Travel costs

To calculate your travel distance, please use the official Erasmus+ Distance Calculator: <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>

Enter your starting location (the city you will depart from) and Timișoara, Romania as your destination. The tool will give you the total distance in kilometers, which will determine the financial support you are eligible for.

Please note: it does not matter which cities you pass through or how many transfers you have along the way, the calculation is based solely on the starting and ending locations.

Reimbursement: The travel costs will be fully reimbursed by the CONCORDIA Humanitarian Organization, after the mobility, to each participant who attended the full mobility period/ activities, signed the daily attendance list and provided all the requested documents (i.e. Participant Statement, individual expense report, travel documents, a report regarding the dissemination activities organized).

The use of green travel (train, bus, bicycle, carpooling) by participants is encouraged and supported (mandatory if participants travel a distance of up to 500 km).

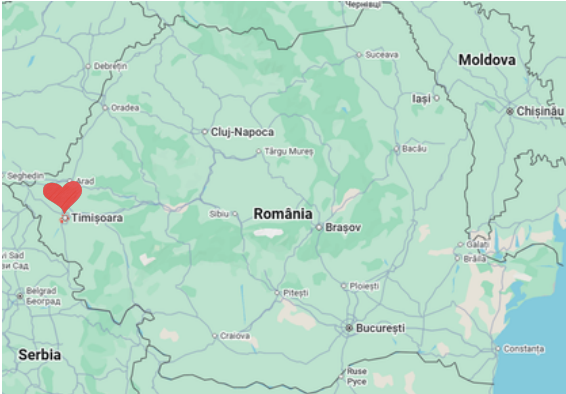
